



Mt Buller Stakeholder Consultative Committee Key Themes Meeting #2

The following topics were discussed at the meeting on 28 March 2024.

Mt Buller discussion points

- **New Staff General Manager** Alan Arthur, commencing on 15 April. He has a diverse background across the public and private sector.
- Winter Transport and Parking arrangements Several initiatives to improve visitor experience, safety and carpark utilisation will be used this year based on feedback from visitors and stakeholders.
- Corn Hill Road Works will commence on the next stage of repairs after the Snow Season.
- **Service Charges** Confirmed that the total collection from service charges will increase by 5%, allocated to properties based on the capital improved value.

ARV Discussion Points

- **Bushfire Insurance** Recommended changes will require changes to the Standard Alpine Lease, which State Government is currently reviewing.
- Alpine Resorts Strategic Plan Feedback has been provided by the SCCs which is being incorporated into the Strategy where relevant. The Plan will then go to the Minister for approval.
- Resort Capacity Analysis ARV is currently in market for a consultant to deliver this project.
- Alpine Leasing Policy The stakeholder refrence group has now been established with representatives from all the SCCs plus representation from the finance and real estate/development sectors.
- **Southern Resorts Dispersal Research Findings** Research was commissioned by ARV to better understand the role that the Southern Resorts play as 'feeders' to the Northern Resorts, and the journey first-time snow visitor take when they progress to skiing/snowboarding.
