

**Mt BAW BAW STAKEHOLDER CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE (SCC)****MEETING #7 – 5 December 2023**

The following topics were discussed at the December meeting of the Mt Baw Stakeholder Consultative Committee.

**Mt Baw Baw specific discussion points**

**Green Season Food and Beverage Operations**

It was confirmed that Village Central will be the key food and beverage site open over summer 2023/24. It will be open Friday to Monday, supported by snacks and drinks being available at other times via guest information. The committee discussed potential changes to winter operations and how staffing could be managed from green season into winter.

**Scoping Work for Additional Toboggan Slope**

Potential for a new toboggan slope down the back of the former guest information site has been scoped and is currently being costed. Implementation is contingent of grant funding previously secured for another project being reallocated for this purpose.

**Mt Baw Baw General Manager Recruitment**

ARV is currently interviewing a strong short list of candidates for the permanent General Manager role and expects an appointment before Christmas.

**ARV 2024 Budget**

**Alpine Resorts Strategic Plan**

The plan is currently being reviewed internally and will next go to the Board and SCCs for review and feedback at the first meeting in the New Year.

**Bushfire Insurance**

ARV is currently looking to garner State Government appetite on the proposed recommendation by KPMG, noting that a change in the alpine lease is required to support the proposed mutual fund.

**Alpine Leasing Policy**

DEECA is supportive of ARV leading the Alpine Leasing Policy review in conjunction with the Department. A proposed engagement plan and timeline has been submitted to DEECA for approval, with ARV anticipating commencing the review process in early 2024.

**ARV Strategic Planning Framework**

ARV has developed a framework that outlines the ecosystem of plans across ARV, with the aim of delivering planning consistency. Next steps include mapping current strategies to the new framework and identifying a timeline for delivery.
