

FALLS CREEK STAKEHOLDER CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE (SCC)**MEETING #3 – 24 June 2026**

The following topics were discussed at the June meeting of the Falls Creek Stakeholder Consultative Committee.

Strategic Planning and Shared Direction

The meeting centred on the development of a long-term strategy for Falls Creek, with strong emphasis on defining a clear future direction, recognising the resort's unique alpine village character, and aligning stakeholders around shared priorities. Discussion highlighted the importance of balancing growth, commercial realities, environmental stewardship and community expectations.

Accessibility and Village Bowl Activation

Operational matters were raised regarding disability access for year-round residents and the need for clearer processes around Village Bowl activations. The Committee discussed case-by-case disability parking options, improved communication about activation opportunities, and the value of developing a clearer precinct vision to guide future expressions of interest and event approvals.

Community Initiatives and Heritage

The Committee noted the success of the Legends Lunch fundraiser, which raised approximately \$4,000 for the Falls Creek Historical Society. Funds will support engineering and final design work for a commemorative seat recognising Lynn Gibbs, reflecting continued community commitment to preserving and celebrating Falls Creek's history.
