



FALLS CREEK STAKEHOLDER CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE (SCC)

MEETING #6 – 7 December 2023

The following topics were discussed at the [month] meeting of the [resort] Stakeholder Consultative Committee.

Falls Creek specific discussion points

Key Worker Housing

ARV Falls Creek will be meeting the Grollo worker housing group to discuss the overall Bogong Village development and opportunities to assist key infrastructure management, like wastewater. A key worker housing fund that has also been announced and ARV Falls Creek needs to submit an application that, if successful, will significantly support the development of Falls Creek sites and the development of prospective opportunities.

Major Road Projects Victoria update

Traffic on the Bogong High Plains Road has increased from 60 to 120 trucks per week. ARV Falls Creek staff are encouraged to use UHF radios, increasing awareness of truck movements. Discussions have taken place with the Department of Transport concerning the condition of the road.

2024 meeting dates

All SCC members were happy with the proposed meeting dates for 2024.

ARV Discussion Points

ARV Strategic Planning Framework

Amber Gardner provided an overview of the ARV Strategic Planning Framework, covering key phases such as performance monitoring, accountability, and progressing to vision, strategy and policy. The next step is to map current strategies to the framework and consider what needs work to conform to the framework. Stakeholders will be engaged on new strategies as relevant.

ARV 2024 Budget

Stakeholder feedback has been considered when finalising the budget, which will be reviewed and endorsed by the ARV Board on 15 December. The final budget will be circulated to stakeholders after that time.

Alpine Resorts Strategic Plan

The Alpine Resorts Strategic Plan is currently being updated ahead of a full rewrite with stakeholder consultation at the end of 2024. It is expected that the updated plan will be reviewed by the ARV Board in December and provided to the SCC for review at its first meeting in 2024.

Bushfire Insurance Strategy – next steps

The preferred model recommended by KPMG is the establishment of a Diversified Mutual Fund. Under this solution, the Victorian Government would need to agree to a non-compliant non-APRA regulated instrument as part of the alpine lease. Therefore the next step is to assess DEECA's appetite for lease change.

Alpine Resorts Leasing Policy

An engagement strategy and timelines developed by ARV is currently under review by DEECA. Once approved, stakeholder engagement can commence.

ARV Brand Rollout

The migration phase of the migration is nearly complete. All staff now have ARV email addresses and corporate collateral will be updated to feature the ARV logo, but individual resorts will retain destination themes for consumer-facing branding. ARV branding is specific to the corporate brand.
