The following topics were discussed at the September meeting of the Falls Creek Stakeholder Consultative Committee.

Falls Creek specific discussion points**Operations Update/Winter Visitation Data**

Falls Creek has had a busy winter season with 89 days of white roads, amplifying the Ski-In/Ski-Out experience. Nightly grooming in the village was effective, and strategies to retain snow on village roads were discussed. There were some challenges with the cross country grooming machinery this season. Despite the setbacks, grooming was carried out daily, and overall the team performed well.

Proposed FY26 Capital Program

FW presented the proposed FY26 Capital Program to the SCC.

Events Update – Proposed FY26 Program

The updated events calendar included changes to the dates of events to accommodate operational turnover.

ARV Discussion Points**Long-Term Financial Plan/2026 Budget**

ARV is focusing on the development of the Long-Term Financial Plan (LTFP), that will underpin the pathway to financial sustainability report. Work on 2026 Budget has commenced earlier than usual to align with the LTFP, which will be brought back to the SCC for feedback.

Alpine Resorts Strategic Plan

Work continues on the Alpine Resorts Strategic Plan, with engagement from the registered aboriginal parties. A draft will be shared with the SCC for review and feedback before the finalised draft will be uploaded to the Engage Victoria site for feedback.

Enterprise Agreement

ARV's EA was approved by the Fair Work Commission and came into effect on 1 August. Work is currently being done to translate all staff over to the new framework.
