

Gas Leak - Gas Emergency Information

What to do when there is a gas leak or emergency:

- If someone's life or property is in danger,
- If someone has been injured,
- If there is a fire or explosion, or
- If you believe a life-threatening situation exists:

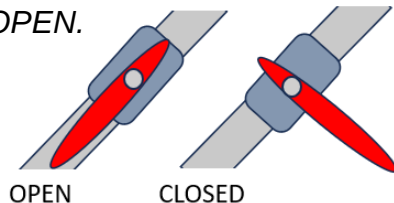
CALL 000 IMMEDIATELY (FIRE - AMBULANCE - POLICE)

If you can smell, hear, or see a gas leak, immediately call Mt Hotham Alpine Resort on **03 5759 3550** (24 hours / 365 days a year) and follow the prompts to report a gas emergency.

- Ensure all persons move to a safe place away from the area where you believe the leak may be.
- L.P. Gas has a strong odorant added to it. The smell will be stronger closer to the leak.
- Turn off or extinguish any source of ignition such as naked flames (fireplace), cigarettes, gas appliances, pilot lights, electrical equipment.
- If safe to do so, turn off the gas supply at the gas meter:

Turn the control tap at the gas meter to the closed position.

Handle in-line with pipe = OPEN.



Handle across pipe = CLOSED.

- If you are unable to turn off the gas supply or are not confident about doing this, please wait for Mt. Hotham Alpine Resort or Emergency Service personnel to arrive.
- If the gas has ignited, keep yourself and others clear.

DO NOT attempt to extinguish the flame yourself.
